

CallTower is Section 889 Compliant

Section 889 compliance is a rule established by the U.S. government banning the purchase or use of technology, products or services from certain companies for government organizations or contractors. These companies are considered a potential threat to national security due to their country of origin. The rule is in place to ensure government entities only use safe and secure technology.

To be Section 889 compliant, companies and organizations who work with the government or receive government money need to ensure the products they purchase or use are not made by the companies mentioned in the rule. If they are, the companies need to find different options that are safe and not from those specific companies. The goal of section 889 compliance is to protect the government's systems and keep them safe from potential security risks.
